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Pyramid Model

What is it?

The Pyramid Model is an evidence-based framework designed to support young children's social and emotional development through a tiered approach that uses intentional teaching strategies to promote positive behaviour.

It supports educators to feel confident, work closely with families, and guide children's growth in areas of social emotional development including self regulation, emotional literacy, problem solving skills and friendship skills.

Through observation, assessment, workshops and real-time coaching, educators receive practical strategies and flexible tools to implement new practices within their everyday routines. This approach fits naturally into play-based learning and supports the creation of safe, inclusive environments where every child can learn, grow and thrive.

Pyramid Model

The Pyramid Model is a tiered approach that is implemented progressively. The complete package includes all steps for program wide implementation. Tiers can be completed over time and specific options according to your learning plan can be organised to support your team to implement the framework according to your needs.

Modes of Delivery:

The Pyramid Model can be delivered:

- Face to Face
- Online
- Hybrid combination of both Face to Face & Online

Out of hours sessions can be arranged as available; specific needs can be discussed.

We have successfully delivered the program to both metropolitan and regional centres.

Pyramid Model Team Members:

All assessments, facilitation and coaching is implemented by qualified allied health professionals additionally certified in the Pyramid Model and Practice Based Coaching.

Pyramid Model – Steps for full Implementation

These steps can be worked through over 2 years if required based on funding and capacity for Educators to ensure quality implementation and supported outcomes.

- 1 Leadership Session** — Align leadership & set foundations
- 2 Pre Assessment** — Baseline observation
- 3 Training Workshops** — Build team knowledge & skills
(13 sequential sessions)
- 4 Coaching Support** — Ongoing practice-based coaching
for practical implementation
- 5 Review of Program** — Evaluate outcomes & sustainability

Step 2– Pre Assessment

The Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool (TPOT) is completed on identified educator/ classroom to identify priorities and support to develop coaching goals and needs. Baseline evaluation tool to outline starting point and become a reference point to demonstrate progress/ outcomes throughout the program.

Workshop Delivery Options:

- Workshops are delivered typically as separate workshops over time.
- Tiers are delivered in order and are pre requisites to subsequent tiers.
- Alternatively workshops 3-13 can be delivered in 2 full days following the introduction sessions; specific preferences can be discussed.

Step 4- Coaching Support

- Can be small group coaching of leading educators or 1:1 as required
- Practice Based Coaching in cycles of 2 sessions each provided to support Educators to build capacity with identified goals to move from knowledge to implementation of the Pyramid Model within their classroom

Step 5- Post Assessment- Review Of Program

The Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool (TPOT) is completed again post implementation to review current practices and measure progress throughout the program.

This step also includes the development of an Impact Report completed to demonstrate program outcomes for the centre.

AHP: Therapeutic Support

We offer a flexible approach to delivering allied health supports to meet the needs of individual centres and their educators.

We match an allied health professional based on your priority areas, and they support your centre and Educators throughout the term to build knowledge, skills and resources within your team.

Terms are booked in 10 week blocks of 2 hours per week and multiple terms can be booked to support different priority areas aligning with your learning plan.

Below are some examples of the types of support that can be provided, however, we'll work with you to design what best fits your team and program needs.

Examples of Supports:

- Providing observation, reflective discussions and recommendations for 1 – 2 areas of focus e.g. transitions, routines, communication, behaviour support
- Planning and co-facilitation of targeted small group work
- Modelling and demonstrating strategies in activities and routines
- Facilitating training session/ webinar and information sessions for families and/or educators
- Development of resources and guides to support implementation of strategies and supports for educators and families
- Review policies and paperwork in specific areas to provide clearer support for team members in identified areas e.g. Behaviour Support
- Specialised support for Early Career Educators to develop skills to work with families including having difficult conversations

AHP: Therapeutic Support Outcomes



Reduced Challenging Behaviour & Increased Emotional and Social Wellbeing

Children build resilience, emotional regulation, and relationship skills. Educators and families model and teach emotional and social development through play and daily activities to have needs met safely.



Participation & Independence

Children develop foundational skills in communication, motor coordination, and daily routines. Adults learn how to promote independence and adapt environments for active engagement.



Communication & Learning

Children improve speech, listening, and early literacy. Adults gain strategies to promote language and cognitive skills through play-based interactions.



Collaborative Support Networks

Families and educators build confidence in understanding development, accessing practical tools, and working as a team across home and preschool settings.

AHP: Therapeutic Support

All services are \$200 per hour, delivered by qualified allied health professionals in blocks of 10 weeks.

Allied Health Professional will work with you to determine the best use of your term support, which can include support in the following modes to make the best use of your funding aligned with your priorities:

- Face-to-Face for observation/ coaching and in person workshops
- Online for coaching check ins and online workshops
- Non-Face-to-Face for resource development, documentation and reviews of relevant policies and procedures
