Who this policy applies to

This policy applies to all representatives of I Can Jump Puddles, including key management personnel, full-time, part-time or casual staff, as well as contractors and volunteers. This policy applies to supports and services provided to all participants.

Policy

I Can Jump Puddles will ensure all employees and contractors have completed the online induction training prior to commencement

Code of Conduct

- Act with respect for individual rights to freedom of expression, self-determination and decision-making in accordance with applicable laws and conventions
- Respect the privacy of people with disability
- Provide supports and services in a safe and competent manner, with care and skills
- Act with integrity, honesty and transparency
- Promptly take steps to raise and act on concerns about matters that may impact the quality and safety of supports and services provided to people with disability
- Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to all forms of violence against, and exploitation, neglect and abuse of, people with disability
- Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to sexual misconduct.
